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NSCFF Creates 1st Ever PASS Network Courses for Parkinson Patients in Miami-Dade County

Neuroscience Centers of Florida Foundation (NSCFF) will offer Parkinson’s patients residing in Miami-Dade County, Lee Silverman Voice Treatment (LSVT), Physical and Occupational Therapy (LSVT BIG) as well as Speech Therapy (LSVT LOUD) programs beginning in August, 2015. Each course will focus on maximum sustained movements, repetitive/directional movements, functional component movements, and phrases.

These courses are a first in Miami-Dade County and will be available to recipients of Medicaid, Obamacare, as well as the uninsured. “NSCFF identified a critical unmet need for patients diagnosed with Parkinson’s disease that wasn’t being served. This will now be addressed due to a recently awarded grant from the National Parkinson Foundation. We’re fully committed to servicing the members of our community afflicted with this disease who have limited access to proper care,” said Jeffrey Horstmyer, MD, FAAN – Chief Executive Officer.
