




Parkinson's Identification Card Form

NSCFF offers a medical ID card to those affected by Parkinson's. This card will serve to identify you as a Parkinson's patient with your doctor's phone number and emergency contact information. In order to receive the ID card, verification of your Parkinson's diagnosis is required, along with a completed form and a \$10 processing fee. You may have your physician sign a statement of your diagnosis on official letterhead or a prescription pad. Physician verification can be faxed or mailed.
